In term of section 149 and other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and Regulation 17 of the Listing Regulation, Ms. Shuba Kumar (DIN: 02081919), being eligible and offering herself for appointment, is proposed to be appointed as Independent Director for a consecutive term of five (5) years with effect from 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2024.

Ms. Shuba Kumar (DIN: 02081919), aged 52 years, was appointed as an Additional Director to function as Independent Director of the Company by the Board of Directors, upon the recommendation of Nomination and Remuneration Committee, with effect from 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2024.

In term of Regulation 17(1C) read with 25(2A) of the Listing Regulations, the Company is required to obtain approval of the Shareholders by way of Special Resolution, for appointment of Ms. Shuba Kumar as an Independent Director on the Board of the Company at the next General Meeting or within three months from the date of appointment, whichever is earlier. Hence, the approval of the Shareholder is being sought through postal ballot for her appointment as an Independent Director on the Board.

The Company has received a Notice in writing from a member proposing her candidature for the office of Independent Director of the Company as per Section 160(1) of the Companies Act, 2013.

The Company has received requisite consent and declarations from her stating that she meets the criteria of independence as provided under Section 149(6) of the Companies Act, 2013 and Regulation 16(1)(b) of the Listing Regulations and in the opinion of the Board, she fulfils the conditions specified in the Companies Act, 2013 read with the Rules framed thereunder and Listing Regulations for appointment as an Independent Director and she is independent of the management.

#### CDSL e-Voting System – For Remote e-voting

#### THE INTRUCTIONS OF SHAREHOLDERS FOR REMOTE E-VOTING:

- (i) The e-voting period will begin at 9:00 a.m. on 08th August, 2024 (Thursday) and ends at 5:00 p.m. on 06<sup>th</sup> September, 2024 (Friday). During this period shareholders of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date Friday, 02<sup>nd</sup> August, 2024 may cast their vote electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.
- (ii) Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 09<sup>th</sup> December, 2020, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders/retail shareholders is at a negligible level.

Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.

In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts/ websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants. Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease and convenience of participating in e-voting process.

(iii) In terms of SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 09<sup>th</sup> December, 2020 on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.
